ePolicy is a **EU project** funded under the **Seventh Framework Program** in the call **ICT tools for Governance and Policy modeling**. Its main aim is **to support policy makers in their decision process**.

For the first time, **global (regional) and individual perspectives** on the decision process are merged and integrated in a **computational model** that aims to optimize the policy decision process in its life cycle.

The Conference will present the results obtained in the **three-year life time** of the project and the possibility of their re-use in other policy domains or in the industrial sector.

In a **Demonstration Area** managed by the **University of Bologna** it will be possible to test the system prototype for regional planning.
